Aloha Residents, Families and Responsible Parties;

Due to Honolulu's recent increase in COVID-19 cases, including breakthrough cases where vaccinated individuals are testing positive for COVID-19, now is a good time to remind visitors of our visitation guidelines. These guidelines are in place to protect your loved ones from potential exposure to COVID-19.

Our guidelines are consistent with those of the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid (CMS) and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) for nursing homes. Visitation guidelines must be **adhered to at all times during your visit.**

Guidelines (rules) for visitation:

- All visitations requests **MUST** be scheduled through the **Social Services Department (808-441-9564)**
- **Please present your COVID-19 vaccination card upon your first visit to the facility.**
- Visitation duration is 45 minutes for outdoor visits and 60 minutes for indoor visits.
- A maximum of five (5) visitors per outdoor visit.
- A maximum of two (2) visitors per in-facility visit.
- A maximum of two (2) outdoor in-person visit will be conducted at a time.
- Visitors will be screened and observed for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 prior to visitation.
- Please remain in your vehicle until your scheduled visitation time. Please do not sit on the front or side lanai waiting for your scheduled visitation time.
- Visitors will wear face covering/mask at all times during visit (nose and mouth covered)
- Visitation will occur only in designated visitation location, indoor or outdoor (movement and walking around premises is not permissible during visit).
- Visitors will adhere to social distancing (6-foot distance), when possible, this continues to be the safest way to prevent the spread of COVID-19, particularly if either party has not been fully vaccinated.
- Fully vaccinated residents can choose to have close contact (including touch) with their visitor while wearing well-fitting face mask and performing hand hygiene before and after.
- Visitors must physically distance from other residents and staff.
- No eating and drinking during visitation.
- Children under the age of 12 are not permitted to visit.
- Fully vaccinated children 12 years and older are permitted participate in, in-facility visits.
- Unvaccinated children 12 years and older are permitted to outdoor visits only.
- Visitation may be monitored for adherence of CMS Core Principles of COVID-19 infection prevention and visitation guidelines.
- ANRC will allow visits to be conducted with an adequate degree of privacy.

Screeners are provided the daily visitation schedule. If more visitors arrive than scheduled, the extra visitors will not be permitted to visit and advised to call Social Services to schedule their visitation date and time.



ANRC reserves the right to stop a visit or deny visitation privileges if visitors are unable to adhere to the COVID-19 infection prevention and visitation guidelines (rules).

Residents who are on transmission-based precautions for COVID-19 (New Admissions and suspected COVID-19) will only receive visits that are virtual, or in-person for compassionate care situations, with adherence to transmission-based precautions.

New admissions:

- Quarantine for fully vaccinated individuals is 5 days
- Quarantine for unvaccinated individuals (or when vaccination status is not confirmed by day 4 of admission) is 14 days

In conjunction with in-person visits we will continue to offer telephone calls and virtual visits. Please schedule virtual visits through our Therapeutic Recreation Department 247-2220 ext. 553.

If you start developing signs and symptoms of COVID-19, have a confirmed or possible COVID-19 exposure, or suspect or are confirmed with COVID-19 please notify the facility as soon as possible!

Your loved ones' health, safety and well-being is our top priority. Please take the precautions to protect your loved one and abide by the visitation guidelines. If you have questions or concerns, please call 247-2220 ext. 536 for Vanessa.
